FIRE SAFETY

Please do not move or alter site features such as log and Fire Circles.

Fires must only be set within the Fire Circles

Do not leave fires unattended and observe all Fire Safety procedures

All vehicles are only permitted in the designated Car Park and parked at the Owners own risk

Any Electrical Equipment brought onto site must have a current PAT test.

Fire Safety

A Fire Extinguisher and Fire Blanket is located in the Kitchen

Please evacuate to the Car Park at the front of the site, this can be reached following the pathway in front of the Main building or from behind the Bathroom Block.

If both pathways are obstructed an alternative exit can be made at the bottom of the field. At the bottom of that field is a residential area and main road.

Things To Remember please:

Only light fires in the fire pit and not on the grass.

Please do not use the seating logs on the fire or chop any trees on site.

No Vehicles on the grassed areas

Do not put any sanitary items, tissues or wet wipes down the toilet as they block the system.

Be aware that the showers and toilets can become slippy.

Inform ASAP, if anything gets lost or damaged so that it can be replaced or fixed.

Make sure all tent pegs are removed from the ground, as any left will damage the lawnmower.

On a campsite there are always known hazards and Campers will be made aware of them In accordance to the SOOA Risk Assessment.
